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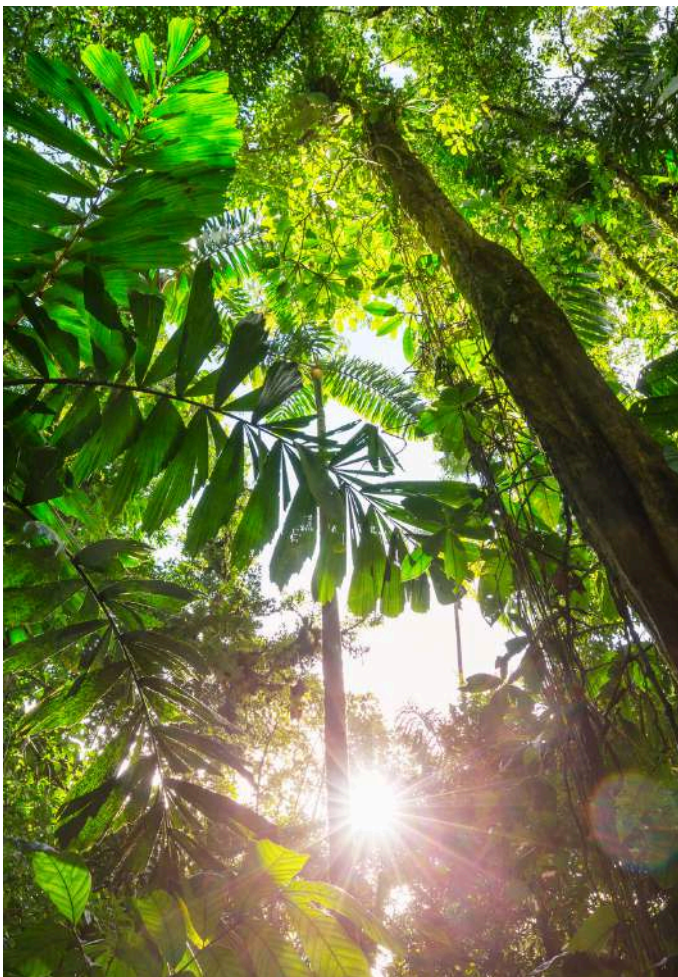

DAY 1

Arrival Day

Upon arrival in Costa Rica's we will drive out of the capital, where you'll have time to rest after your journey. In the evening, we'll gather for our first group meeting to go over the itinerary and prepare for the adventure ahead.

DAY 2 Caribbean Coast Adventure

After breakfast and a quick exploration of the area, we'll start the day riding through beautiful landscapes filled with history, crops, and different types of forests.

As we reach the Caribbean coast, we'll board a motorboat with our e-bikes and cruise along lush, wildlife-rich natural canals. This scenic ride will take us to the river mouth, where we'll dip our feet in the salty waters of the Caribbean Sea — the official start of our big expedition.

We'll ride through tropical forests, feel the warm and humid air, and learn about banana farming. We'll even stop to visit a banana packing plant and see how bananas from Costa Rica are prepared for export around the world.

The route begins mostly flat, but don't be fooled — the real challenge is the tropical climate. As we head into the mountains, the elevation rises and we'll be rewarded with breathtaking views.

DAY 3

Conquering the Mountains

We'll continue our climb, reaching a maximum altitude of 1,440 meters (4,724 ft). We'll then tackle our first big downhill ride through sugarcane fields, learning about the crop and sampling fresh sugarcane. On the way, we'll stop at a local bike park to ride the trails and sharpen our skills. The day ends with a ride through small towns and old railway paths, arriving at our Lodging.

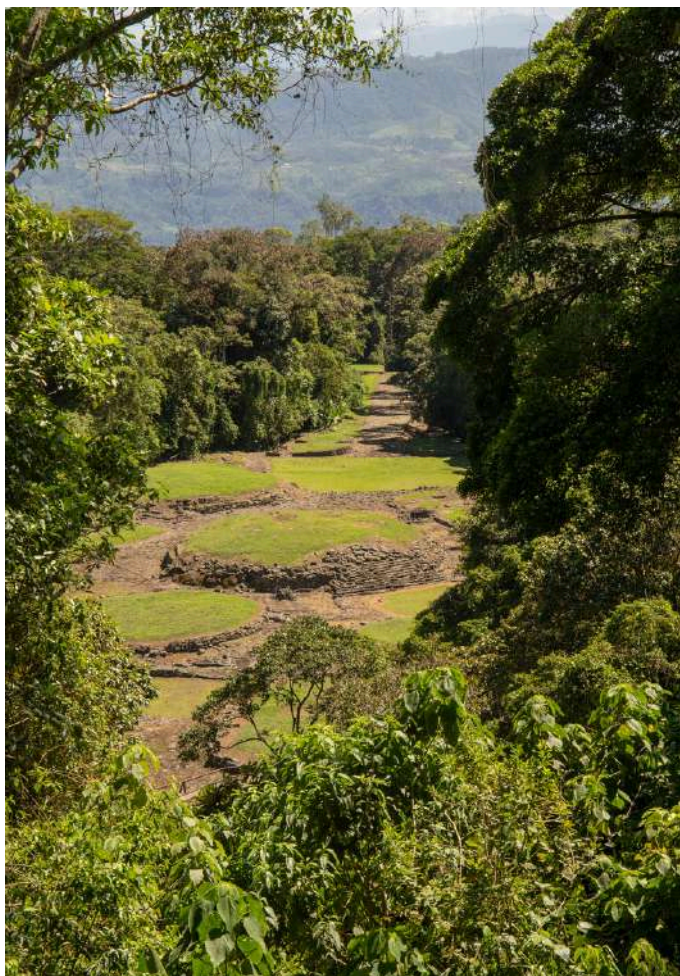

DAY 4

Scaling Costa Rica's Tallest Mountain Range

Back into the mountains. We'll enter Costa Rica's highest mountain range, discovering an entirely new type of forest. The high altitude and cool climate will test us, but with the help of our e-bikes, warm-hearted locals, and fresh coffee, we'll push forward. At a certain point, to avoid heavy traffic, we'll use support vehicles to reach our highland hotel for a well-deserved rest.

Aprox. Distance: 35 km / 23 mi

Ride: Technical climb

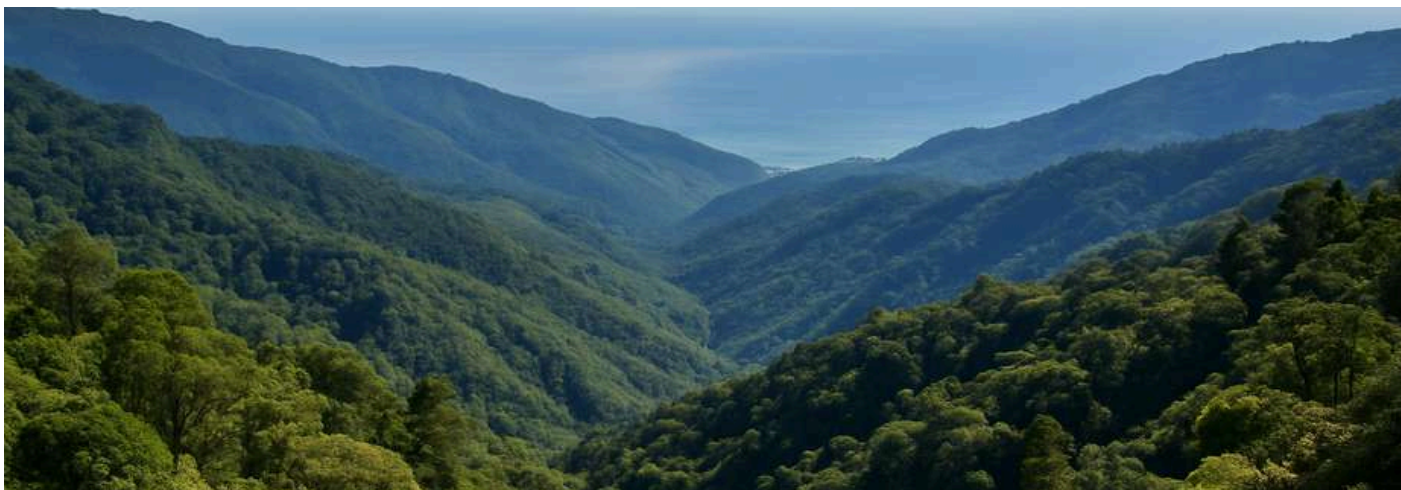

DAY 5

Final Descent to the Pacific Ocean

Today we head to Costa Rica's coffee paradise. Riding through coffee plantations, we'll visit a processing facility for a full tour of the bean-to-cup journey — ending, of course, with a delicious tasting. In the afternoon, we ride toward the Pacific, with more downhill thrills as we make our way to the hot, flat lowlands. We'll pass through endless fields of African palm, learning about this important (and controversial) crop and observing the workers' efforts. The heat will be palpable, but so will the reward: by day's end, we'll reach the Pacific Ocean after crossing the entire country.
